Vorwort:

"Ich zähle einen zweiten Geburtstag, eine wahre Wiedergeburt von dem Tag an, an dem ich Rom betrat".

So schrieb *Johann Wolfgang von Goethe* in seinem Werk *"Italienische Reise"* (1816/1829), überwältigt von der Schönheit der Landschaft, der Harmonie der Formen und Farben und dem verklärenden Licht.

Tatsächlich gilt Italien auch heute noch als Land des Lichts und der Mode, der Freiheit und der Fröhlichkeit, der Feste und Feiern und der schönen Menschen.

Die Unbekümmertheit der Italiener und ihre Lebensfreude stehen zu Beginn des Marsch-Intermezzos "Bella Italia" im Mittelpunkt, gefolgt von einer rhythmisch akzentuierten, "modernen" Überleitung - hin zum Finale, welches den Nationalstolz der Italiener - unter Verwendung des bekanntesten Themas aus der italienischen Nationalhymne - musikalisch hervorhebt.

Ein wesentlicher Teil der Geschichte stand ganz im Zeichen Roms, welches bis heute als Inbegriff weltlicher und christlicher Geschichte gilt; die Italiener sind stolz auf ihre Vergangenheit und auf ihre Musik.

Die von *Michele Novaro* (1818-1885) komponierte Nationalhymne "Fratelli d'Italia" bekannt auch als "L'Inno di Mameli" gehört zweifellos zu den schönsten und bekanntesten Nationalhymnen der Welt.


